

* Police officers as defined in Criminal Procedure Law Section 1.20 (34)(a)-(s) - active or retired within 5 years of service.

* Federal Law enforcement officers as defined in CPL Section 2.15 (1)-(29). These designations include the military police-active or retired within 5 years of service.

* Peace officers as defined in Criminal Procedure Law Section 2.10 -- currently active only. Those applicants must provide proof of:

- o current DCJS certification

- o NYS Peace Officers as defined in CPL Section 2.14 (currently active only) who can provide proof of current DCJS certification and current annual Article 35 and live fire qualification. (See Attached Training Bulletin) The DCJS training requirements FAR exceed those of our course; 7 hours Article 35 and 40 hours live fire initially plus annual requalification of 3 hours of Article 35 and 5 hours of live fire as well as a written test using the DCJS question pool.
